DIRECTIONS:

COMING FROM THE EAST OR SOUTH: FROM THE SPAULDING TURNPIKE OR ROUTE 202 FOLLOW ROUTE 11. At the Alton Traffic Circle following Route 11 turn ¼ around traffic circle, head towards Alton Bay, go past Dunkin Donuts on your right and go right into the Town of Alton, after TD Bank on your right, there is a road on your LEFT, this is Route 140. Please look for this intersection as it isn't marked well. Turn LEFT onto Route 140 and follow approximately 8 miles, you will come down into the Town of Gilmanton, NH and just as you are leaving Main Street, there will be a road on your RIGHT called CRYSTAL LAKE ROAD. Take this right onto Crystal Lake Road. As soon as you turn onto Crystal Lake Road, there is a FORK in the road STAY TO THE LEFT, follow for approximately 3 miles around the lake, the road will automatically change to GUINEA RIDGE ROAD. Stay on this road, it will turn to DIRT. Stay on this until you come upon the SMART RIDE on your RIGHT.

COMING FROM THE SOUTH: Driving on Highway 93, take Exit 20, get in the RIGHT LANE, there will be a set of lights, go STRAIGHT thru the intersection onto Route 140. Stay on Route 140 for approximately 20 miles. Follow through Belmont, Cross over to Route 106, staying on Route 140 the whole way. Come to a STOP SIGN and YELLOW BLINKING LIGHT, Go straight through. Stay on Route 140, go another 5 miles, then look for a road on your LEFT called CRYSTAL LAKE ROAD. Turn left onto Crystal Lake Road, once you turn onto Crystal Lake Road, there is a FORK in the road, STAY TO THE LEFT. Follow for approximately 3 miles around the lake, the road will automatically turn into GUINEA RIDGE ROAD. Stay on this road, it will change to DIRT. Stay on till you come upon SMART RIDE on your RIGHT.
